Bid 09-10 Questions and Addendum #1

Question #1:

The BOM does not list maintenance on the equipment besides the 2821. Do you require SMARTnet coverage on any of the other equipment (6509, 3560, 2960, IP phones, etc.) and if so, what level of maintenance is required and how many years.

Answer #1:

GPISD is not purchasing SMARTnet coverage on anything except for the 2821's at this time

Question #2:

The Cisco Configuration Tool requires part number MEM-MSFC3-1GB (List Price \$4,800.00) to be included in your 6500 configurations. Should we include this component even though it's not specified in the BOM?

Question #3:

What power cord should be included for the Catalyst 6500? Do you require 110V or 220V and what plug type should be included?

Answer #3:

GPISD requests the following power cable per power supply:

CAB-AC-C6K-TWLK= 250Vac 16A, twist-lock NEMA L6-20 plug

Answer #4:

On page 9 of 15 in the RFP it is stated that "GPISD wishes to take ownership of the materials specified in the spreadsheet as the soonest possible date." Do you anticipate purchasing prior to the end of the year with shipments occurring this year (2008) as well.

Answer #4:

GPISD will submit the recommend response to the GPISD Board of Trustees on December 11, 2008. GPISD hopes to get the appropriate paperwork to the selected vendor before the end of the calendar year. GPISD expects shipments to occur only in 2009 due to the small time window left available for internal GPISD processes.
