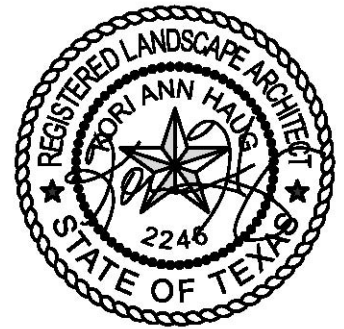

This **Addendum No. 1** forms a part of the Contract Documents and modifies the original proposal documents prepared **October 13, 2008**. Answers/Clarifications to questions below are shown in **red**.

CHANGES TO DRAWINGS, SPECIFICATIONS, BIDDING REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) Room 209 thru 212 were not open to us (the group). Are these rooms to be omitted?
(Include one marker board per room (4' x 12'))
- 2) The specifications call for e-z stick skins and e-z fit panels are both products to be bid for each room ?
(Yes)
- 3) What warranty is expected from the contractor?
(One year from acceptance, plus any manufacturer warranty)

- 4) Can Sunday be used as a workday instead of Christmas Day?
(Yes)
5. We were told there would be an addendum to the bid however I do not see one posted on line. Should we still expect one?
(Issued 10-17-08)
6. We are pricing insert magnetic markers boards (with frame) vs the porcelain on steel skins. We were instructed to quote the insert boards using a nominal measurement and the skins using the actual existing board measurement. For example: If a room has a board with an actual measurement of 41" x 215" we were instructed to quote a 4x16 insert board. When quoting skins do you want the actual measurement to be 41" x 16ft or 41" x 215"?
(Actual size)
7. Who is responsible for removing all paperwork / decorations from the existing boards?
The classroom teachers or the awarded vendor?
(GPISD)
8. The bid is requesting roof drawings and general requirements refer to a roofing bid. Is this an error in the bid paperwork?
(Error, delete all references to roofing)
9. Are submittals to be forwarded after award of the bid or with the bid paperwork?
(After bid)
10. Bid date and time remains the same.

CLARIFICATIONS:

- 1) The successful Contractor should receive a Letter of Intent by October 28, 2008.
- 2) Bonding and insurance requirements must be met before work can begin.
- 3) The pay application process is as follows: pay applications submitted by the 25th of the month will be paid by the 25th of the following month.
- 4) Construction start is December 22, 2008 and complete by January 2, 2009.
