

GPISD Mentor Opportunities

Grant-Funded Level 1 Mentor:

- \$1800/per mentee stipend
- One mentee per mentor
- Application required- available on HR website
- Recommended by principal, selected by grant committee
- For teachers new to the profession
- Required to attend a 2-day training, either June 18-19 or July 28-29
- There are time/effort requirements for this position to meet the guidelines of the grant

Grant-Funded Level 2 Mentor:

- \$2000/per mentee stipend
- One mentee per mentor
- Application required- available on HR website
- Recommended by principal, selected by grant committee
- For teachers new to the profession in critical need areas: SPED, BIL/ESL, Math (gr. 8-12), Science (gr. 8-12)
- Required to attend a 2-day training, either June 18-19 or July 28-29
- There are time/effort requirements for this position to meet the guidelines of the grant
- Mentor must have or have a plan to attain certification and/or specialized training in critical need area

Grant-Funded Master Mentor Level 3:

- \$2500/per mentee stipend
- Must be able to work during school
- All Level 3 Positions Currently Filled
- Required to attend a 2-day training, either June 18-19 or July 28-29
- There are time/effort requirements for this position to meet the guidelines of the grant
- Maximum of 10 mentees
- This mentor assists campus grant-funded mentors with special needs cases
- This mentor also assists with grant compliance and required documentation
- Mentor also eligible to serve as Quality Act mentor teacher

Title II Campus Buddy Mentors:

- \$300/per mentee stipend
- Selected by Principal
- Provided to all experienced teachers new to the district
- Required to attend a 2-day training, either June 18-19 or July 28-29 (\$100/per day stipend will be paid to this group)
- Max of 3 mentees per mentor
- There are time/effort requirements for this position to meet the guidelines of the district
