Classroom is an app for teachers, available for supported iPad devices and Mac computers, to hold classes in a schoolroom, remotely, or through a combination of nearby and remote locations (called *hybrid classes*).

When teaching in class, you can launch a specific app, website, or textbook page. You can also send documents to and receive them from your students, and share student work locally on a TV, monitor, or projector using Apple TV. Finally, you can see which apps students are working in and, at the end of the class, view a summary of how students spent their time.

** At this time, Schoolwork and shared devices are not supported in GPISD*

Using the Classroom app on your device, you can perform actions on each student’s device to focus their attention and guide their learning.

[Create student groups in Classroom](#)

When you’re using Classroom, you can select certain student devices to perform actions on. You can always select a single student to perform actions on their device. For more than one student, you may want to use a specific group. There are three types of groups used in Classroom: Smart groups, Dynamic groups, or Groups you create manually

[Mute student devices in Classroom](#)

You can mute students’ devices (nearby classes only). This sets the volume to 0. If students want to, they can then manually increase the volume again.

You can manage app usage on students’ devices, including opening, hiding, and sharing information through various apps.

[Use the Class Summary pane in Classroom](#)

The Class Summary pane lets you review each student’s use of their device during the previous class session.
