<b>Description</b>	Little or no ability to speak Spanish on <b>social</b> topics.	Ability to speak in a simple manner on <b>social</b> topics using routine Spanish.	Ability to speak in a somewhat fluent manner about social or <b>academic</b> topics.	Ability to speak in a generally fluent manner about a variety of <b>academic</b> and social topics.
<b>Fluency</b>	Attempts to respond in Spanish, but relies heavily on English; long, frequent pauses or simply remains silent.	Responds in Spanish to questions about social topics; pausing frequently.	Responds in Spanish on social topics and <b>attempts</b> to discuss <b>academic</b> topics; some pauses still evident.	Responds in Spanish on both social and <b>academic</b> topics with only a few unnatural pauses.
<b>Vocabulary</b>	Uses limited vocabulary (single words, short phrases).	Uses a wider vocabulary, but with few details; still relies on familiar, practiced words.	Uses social and limited academic vocabulary; can restate ideas with alternative terms.	Uses a wide range of both social and <b>academic</b> vocabulary.
<b>Grammar</b>	Demonstrates a lack of knowledge of grammar in the present tense, sometimes not conjugating verbs, with frequent errors.	Demonstrates a limited knowledge of grammar in present and past with some errors.	Demonstrates an increasing knowledge present, past, and future tenses with some errors.	Demonstrates ability to use grammatical structures and tenses, including the subjunctive mood.
<b>Communication</b>	Communication is generally hindered by language acquisition and pronunciation errors.	Communications is occasionally hindered by language acquisition and pronunciation errors.
