GPISD Education Foundation Executive Board Meeting

July 13, 2021

Meeting called to order by Mary Dominguez-Santini at 1:30 p.m. at the Pioneer Event Center

Members present: Mary Dominguez-Santini, Heather Anderson, Lesta Watson, Karla Chandler, and Denise Clifton

The purpose of this meeting was to discuss preparations of the proposed budget for 2021-2022.

The following items were discussed and given approval by the consensus of the committee as additions, information, and recommendations to the budget to be presented at the annual meeting to be held on July 22, 2021:

- Scholarship Awards for May 2022 will be distributed from the investment portfolio of the organization
- Donations to the Hispanic Heritage Ambassadors DFW will continue to maximum amount of \$6000, per the motion recorded at the February 8, 2021, board minutes
- The 2021 Summer Camp (Rangers) came in under budget and the invoices have been paid in full, including the service fees (funds were distributed from the investment portfolio for the initiative). Heather will be contacting Amy Francis to have the service fees refunded per the motion approved by the Board.
- Mini Grants will resume for this school year with a launch in the Spring semester of 2022. Goal of 100 teacher awards of \$500 each to be added to the proposed budget. The committee recommends that the application be revised to state that items purchased through grant funds to remain on the campus where the award was presented.
- The Education Foundation will sponsor four (4) stand-alone events for purpose of fundraising and community involvement.
- The Executive Committee proposes that the 50th Anniversary Event be changed to accommodate an outdoor event with focus on community participation, with plans to be determined.
- The Executive Committee proposes adding a spring event for Lone Star Park, with plans to be determined. After a review of the Main Event project, the plans at that location have been tabled at the present time.
- Mary requested that the Foundation participate in a Hispanic Chamber event at the Farmer's Market on September 18, 2021 (more details forthcoming)
- The Committee sited the need for a marketing committee
- Heather Anderson will research crowd funding options and report to the Board
