ALWAYS REQUIRED: For safety requirements, student identification badges must be worn **AT ALL TIMES** around/near the neckline.

ALWAYS ALLOWED: Dubiski Career-Specific Uniforms—Cosmetology, Health Science, Dentistry, Culinary Arts, Auto Technology

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Blouses, collared shirts, or sweaters with conservative neckline All shirts must have sleeves Vests with collared shirt Blazers or business jackets Sweaters – pullover, turtleneck, or cardigan-style Logos on shirts must be no larger than a student ID badge 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Flannel, Denim, Camouflage Oversized, baggy, or off-the-shoulder clothing See-through clothing, including mesh style shirts Spandex, vinyl, or stretch-type material Tank tops, narrow strap tops, or tops without straps Tight, low, or midriff-baring clothing T-shirts – crew or V-neck, short/long-sleeved, extra-long, or dry-fit, jerseys Sweatshirts Garment with wearable hood (hoodies)
PANTS – DRESSES - SKIRTS	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dockers or similar style pants and slacks Pants must be worn at the waist All pants must have appropriate fit and be hemmed Skirts and dresses must be at an appropriate length (3 in. from top of the knee) Dresses must have capped, short, three-quarter, or longer sleeves with conservative neckline 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Denim, camouflage, flannel (pajamas) Coveralls/overalls or suspenders Jeans and jean-style pants (of any color) Leggings, fitness, or yoga-style pants Pants tucked into socks, shoes, boots Oversized or baggy clothing Pants with tears, rips, or holes Shorts, skorts, cargo pants, sweatpants, joggers (pants with elastic at the top or bottom)
OUTERWEAR	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All outerwear must fit appropriately and be worn with an acceptable dress shirt Letter jackets and solid-colored jackets of similar weight and style may be worn in the building 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Jacket/coats with hood (may not be worn in the building) A school approved shirt must be worn under all jackets
SHOES – SOCKS – BELTS - ACCESSORIES	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Loafer-style shoes, dress shoes, dress boots Solid or neutral colored tennis shoes Sandals and heels with backstraps or enclosed heels that are business appropriate Leather or canvas-style belts with a buckle no larger than a student ID card Ties including bowties Small pierced jewelry DCHS Student Identification cards (around/near neckline) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Chains that attach to wallets or clothing Flip-flops, athletic-style slides, Crocs, house shoes, Heelys, Uggs-style or combat boots, sandals without backstraps or with open heels (slides) Studded bracelets, belts or necklaces, visible disruptive body piercing, ear gauges, spiked earrings Hats/head coverings of any kind (exceptions for religious purposes) Headbands with attached ears or accessories Sunglasses, bandanas Hosiery with holes (fishnet)

*The campus administrator may designate spirit days and will determine what can be worn on those days.

**The campus administrator reserves the right to establish rules during the school year regarding new fashion in dress.

***In addition to these requirements, students must follow GPISD dress code requirements at all times.
