**Accountability Ratings**

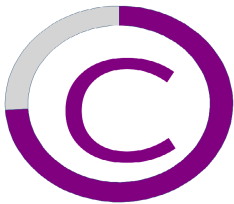

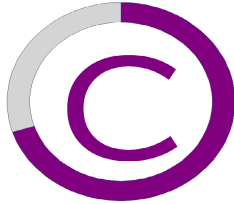

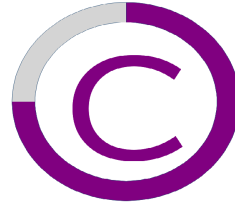
