Program-at-a-Glance

- One semester long
- Begins in January
- Combination of face-to-face and online coursework
- Student teaching in an experienced teacher's classroom for the duration of the semester
- Ongoing support by Site Coordinator through fall semester
- District-paid program fee* for select candidates
