What is Title One?

Largest federal assistance program for schools

Goal of Title One is a higher quality education for EVERY child

Program serves MILLIONS of children

How it works

Federal government provides funding to states based on CENSUS and POVERTY data each year for Title One

The Texas Education Agency send them money to the local school districts

GPISD identifies eligible schools (based on free/reduced lunch percentages) and provides Title One funds

Schools use the money to provide additional services and materials for students

Parent Rights

Be involved

Be provided with information from teachers on academic achievement and behavior

Receive information on the qualifications of your child's teacher

Be informed if your child is taught by a non-certified teacher for four or more consecutive weeks

Who decides how Title One funds are used?

Each school (including ours!) has a school advisory committee composed of parents, teachers and other staff that work at the school and in our community, and the principal

This is the Campus Improvement Committee

The Campus Improvement Committee approves all Title One expenses

Parent Involvement Policy

Florence Hill Elementary School will involve parents in the joint development of the Title I plan and the process of school review and improvement.

Parents will be provided with opportunities for regular meetings to formulate suggestions, share experiences with other parents, and participate in decisions relating to the education of their children.

Parents will receive a timely response to their suggestions.

The school will coordinate and provide technical assistance and other support necessary to help parents actively participate in planning and implementing the parent involvement program.

Parent involvement will be coordinated and integrated with the parent involvement strategies. Parents will receive all information concerning Parent and Child Together (PACT) and Learning Elevated for All Parents (LEAP).

The school will develop with and distribute to parents a written parental involvement policy that describes the requirements in an understandable and uniform format.

The school district will submit the parent involvement plan to the Texas Education Agency, along with comments expressing dissatisfaction with the parent involvement program.
