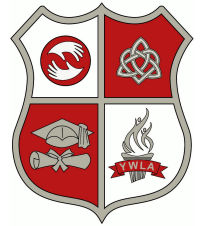


# Young Women's Leadership Academy at Arnold

We are a part of the Young Women's Preparatory Network that embraces the core values of leadership, college readiness and wellness life skills. We focus on developing future leaders who are college-ready and college-bound. We are a designated T-STEM Academy with focused instruction in Science, Technology, Engineering and Math. Leveraging our 1:1 iPad mobile technology, the administration and staff support, model and encourage student choice and creativity to empower students to become producers of content, find their own voice, and become lifelong learners.

## Learning

YWLA provides a common learning experience for all students through a series of weekly Advisory lessons, "Journey Through the Apple Apps, One bite at a time". Classroom teachers reinforce and apply skills to new learning in content areas and innovate new ideas.

- We provide rich learning experiences with choice to make learning personal and meaningful. Girls are producers of content, creating products based on learning modality to demonstrate learning and share. Students help each other learn.
- Students connected through Keynote and Pages that allow for collaboration on projects and the sharing of files through shared albums in iCloud.
- Students learn to code using Swift Playgrounds.
- Teachers and students create tutorials using iMovie to help others learn content, review resources and create fun activities to share.
- 100% of staff are Apple Teachers. They participate in campus professional development, GPISD Apple Vanguard, Apple Education Learning Series [Canvas Course](#), iLearn Conferences and Innovative Schools Leadership Book Studies.
- Teachers utilize the [Apple Teacher Learning Center](#) to integrate technology and screencast lessons on the iPad and Mac.
- Train Apple Teacher Cadres for subject areas that support peer teachers in integration.
