





DCHS Pathway Experiences



Criteria for Admission/ High Expectations

- -95% or higher student attend (including excused absences)
- -Acceptable Grades
- -Acceptable Behavior
- -Ability to complete scheduled degree plan
- -Structured support process in place for students struggling to meet

Attendance

- -95% or higher student attendance (including excused absences)
- -Over 4 classes missed per semester requires attendance recovery for credit (excused or unexcused) unless reviewed by the attendance committee
- -Absences require a note within 3 days to mark as excused
- -The 3rd unexcused absences triggers a truancy file a behavior meeting is required after 10

School Safety

- -Locked doors
- -ID badges required around neck at all times
- -Visitors must enter on the south side of the building
- -Visitors must check in and show identification at the reception desk
- -Security guard and School Resource

Dress Code

What to Wear: Acceptable District-wide

- 1. Slacks
- 2. Dresses (approximately 3 inches from the top of the knee, conservative neckline)
- 3. Skirts (approximately 3 inches from the top of the knee)
- 4. Split skirts (approximately 3 inches from the top of the knee)
- 5. Business appropriate dress shoes and solid/neutral athletic shoes
- 6. Earrings for boys and girls (not of a disruptive nature)
- 7. Tops/Shirts must have conservative neckline
- 8. Tops/Shirts must have collars for men
- 9. Pants must be worn at waist height and should have a professional fit (not too tight or loose)
- 10. ID Badges must be worn on lanyard around neck at all times
- 11. Solid-colored leggings/tights acceptable with shirt/dress/skirt length approximately 3 inches from the top of the knee
- 12. See-through clothing with appropriate clothing underneath for full coverage
- 13. Small facial piercings that are non-disruptive in nature
- 14. Dubiski-specific uniforms: cosmetology, health science, dentistry, culinary, auto, aviation, diesel, etc.

Dress Code

What NOT to wear: Unacceptable at DCHS due to Business Casual Dress Code

- 1. Denim jeans and denim skirts (regardless of color)
- 2. Shorts
- 3. Uncollared shirts for men
- 4. Headbands with attached ears or large accessories
- 5. Any garment with a wearable hood
 - Note: students may wear a hooded garment when outside in the weather but will not be able to wear the hooded garment in the climate-controlled building
- 6. Athletic Gear
 - Sweatshirts, short/long-sleeved t-shirts, hoodies, yoga pants, joggers, dry-fit, etc.
 - Note: PE students will be able to change into athletic gear for that period only.
 - Jeggings/tight stretch jeans/patterned leggings/patterned tights
- 7. Flip-flops, athletic-style slides, Crocs, slippers, house-shoes, UGG-style boots, and brightly colored/patterned athletic shoes

What NOT to wear: Unacceptable District-Wide

- 1. Bare midriffs/strapless tops/low cut, revealing tops/narrow strap tops or dresses
- 2. Mesh shirts, tank tops, cut off shirts
- 3. See-through clothing, visible undergarments
- 4. Cut, frayed or raveled clothing (where skin is revealed)
- 5. Hats, caps, head coverings, or bandannas may not be brought into the building
- 6. Studded bracelets, belts, or necklaces, visible, disruptive body piercing, ear gauges, spike earrings
