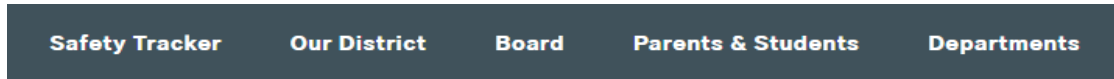


Skyward's Family & Student Access

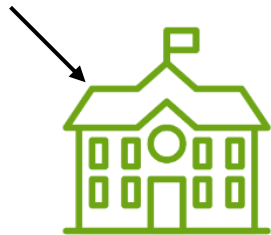

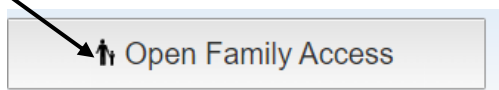

Under the District Resources column, you will find the Skyward link. Click there.

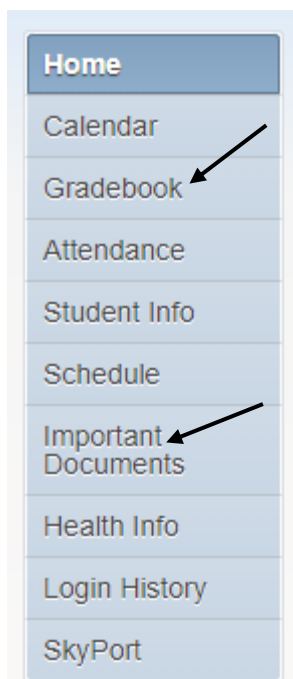

Type your Log In information and Password. Change the Login Area to Family/Student Access if it is not already set.

Locate the Open Family Access button found on the top right-hand side of the screen once you log in.



Once you open Family Access, you will see your child's name located in the top left-hand side next to the Skyward logo. If you have multiple students, there will be a drop-down menu with each student listed. If you should find that a student is missing. Please call that child's school to have them added to your account. You will also find the following links/buttons on the top left-hand side. See below.



You will click on the Gradebook tab to view your student's grades. This is a view into the teacher's gradebook with your student's current grades.

If you would like to view an actual copy of the Progress Report/Report Card/Transcript (High School students 10th-12th), you can select the Important Documents to view them. You will have the option to view current as well as past documents if your students were an active student during that time.

To view another student's grades on your account, you must go back to the student's name and click the drop-down to select another student.
