Morning Entry

Multiple entries will be available for students to enter the building beginning at 7:00 each morning. Each entry location will be staffed with school personnel to ensure that students are wearing proper face covering. We ask that students not be dropped off at school prior to 7:05 am each morning unless they have a specific appointment/activity to attend.

Afternoon Dismissal

Dismissal each day will be staggered to allow for ease of dismissal while maintaining social distancing requirements. Students will be expected to leave campus by 3:15 each day and avoid congregating at building exits.

Breakfast

Breakfast will be available each morning beginning at 7:05 and will be served in a grab-and-go style. Students that eat breakfast on campus will go through the cafeteria line, grab their breakfast, and report to their first class of the day to eat their breakfast.

Lunch

We will maintain 4 lunches each day on both the main campus and in the Dr. Alexander building. Students will follow social distancing protocols during lunch. The number of students at cafeteria tables will be restricted to allow social distancing guidelines to be observed. Microwaves will not be available.

Face Covering

South Grand Prairie High School has a limited supply of masks for student use. Students are expected to come to school each day with an approved mask. If the student refuses to wear a mask, the student will not be allowed to enter any building on the South Grand Prairie High School campus.

The use of masks/face coverings will be strictly enforced throughout the school day. All students are expected to comply with the face covering policy. Students that fail to comply with instructions will be subject to disciplinary action for insubordination. See campus principal for exclusions to compliance.

School Supplies

Shared supplies are not recommended for safe classroom use at this time. Therefore, we ask that you please provide students with pens and pencils to prevent sharing. We also suggest that you provide highlighters, a glue stick, a ruler, a small pencil sharpener, and a small pair of scissors to limit the need for sharing these items.

Transportation/School Busses

All busses will be disinfected between bus routes. Students will load from the back to front and unload from the front to the back. Some windows will be lowered to allow for air to circulate. All students will be required to have their school ID badge to badge onto the bus. All bus drivers, monitors, and students will be required to wear a mask at all times.

Water

All water fountains have been turned off for safety purposes. Students are encouraged to bring water bottles from home to carry with them. The main campus has an automatic bottle filler where students can refill their water bottle. Additionally, water will be available for purchase.

Visitors

Visitors will be limited to those that are deemed essential. Visitors will be required to complete the health screening prior to entry and follow GPISD mask policies for the entirety of their visit. Failure to pass the health screening or failure to comply with the mask policy will result in denial of entry or removal from the building.

Deliveries (Food/Gifts)

Parents or delivery services will not be permitted to deliver outside food, drinks, or gifts to South Grand Prairie High School.

Student and Staff Screening Protocols and Responsibilities

Staff will self-screen each morning prior to entry into South Grand Prairie High School. Students will be screened by parents at home before school and monitored during the school day by staff for general symptoms of illness and will be referred to the clinic if symptoms are suspected or present. Screening includes the following:

Verifying that the individual has not been in direct contact with someone that is lab-confirmed COVID-19 positive. Verifying that none of the following symptoms are present:

- Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100 degrees Fahrenheit,
- Loss of taste or smell
- Cough
- Difficulty breathing
- Shortness of breath
- Headache
- Chills
- Sore throat
- Shaking or exaggerated shivering
- Significant muscle pain or aches, and/or Diarrhea

Protocols for Cleaning and Disinfecting

Cleaning and disinfecting will occur on a regular schedule in every classroom, restroom, commons area, and on high-touch surfaces. Every classroom and office area will have disinfectant in a spray bottle with appropriate cleaning cloths/paper provided for employees and students to use on high-touch areas throughout the school day. The disinfectants supplied in the spray bottle in every classroom is medical-grade, and EPA-approved.

Restrooms, cafeterias, and common areas will undergo extensive cleaning each day. The cafeteria will be cleaned between lunches and all restrooms will be deep cleaned a minimum of twice per day.

Notification of Positive COVID Cases

Should a student or staff member have been directly exposed to a COVID positive individual, families and staff will be notified personally. However, please understand that

we will have to safeguard the privacy of the positive individual as governed by federal FERPA and HIPPA standards.

Exposure to COVID

Should a student or staff member be in direct contact with a person who is lab confirmed positive for COVID-19, the staff member or parent is required to communicate with our school nurse. Please call the main number at South Grand Prairie High School 972-343-1500 and ask to be transferred to the nurse's office. The staff member or student should not report to campus. The staff member or student will be quarantined per district guidelines.

Return to School/Work Protocols

All of the following protocols must be met when a student or staff member that was confirmed or suspected to be COVID-19 positive returns to school or work:

1. At least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared; and
2. 24 hours since recovery (resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medication); and
3. Improvement in symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath)

*If you have symptoms and want to come back early, you must obtain a doctor's note clearing for return to work/school based on alternative diagnosis or acute infection test comes back negative for COVID-19.

COVID Prevention and Mitigation Signage

South Grand Prairie High School will have multiple types of signage reminding students and staff of safety protocols. Signage will include reminders to social distance, wear masks, wash hands, use hand sanitizer, complete daily health screening, and clean their spaces. We will also have signs detailing 1-way hallways and stairways, limiting visitors, bathroom limits, and cafeteria seating/spacing.
