Re: Status as a Candidate for School Board

Dear Mr. Jones:

Leasor Crass, P.C. has been retained by the Grand Prairie Independent School District ("District") to assist with the above referenced matter. On Wednesday, January 16, 2019, the District received your application for a place on the ballot for the May 4, 2019 school board election. Upon the filing of an application for a place on the ballot, the District with whom the application is filed shall review the application to determine whether it complies with the requirements as to form, content, and procedure that it must satisfy for the candidate's name to be placed on the ballot. *See* Tex. Elec. Code §141.032(a). If an application does not comply with the applicable requirements, the District shall reject the application and immediately deliver to the candidate written notice of the reason for the rejection. *See* Tex. Elec. Code §141.032(e). Thus, it is the District's duty to review your application and determine compliance with state law.

To be eligible as a candidate for, or elected or appointed to, the office of school board member, a person must have not been finally convicted of a felony from which the person has not been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities. *See* Tex. Elec. Code §141.001(a)(4). The District is in receipt of credible information that you have been convicted of a felony. This information includes a copy of the Court of Appeals decision affirming your guilty plea and conviction. Therefore, you are not eligible to apply to be a candidate for school board and your application has been rejected.

This review and rejection of your application is in compliance with the above-noted statutes. If you have court records showing you have been pardoned or otherwise released from the disabilities of your felony conviction, please provide them to the District within 5 business days. If you do not provide such records within 5 business days, the District will acknowledge on its website receipt of your application and will also inform the public you are ineligible because of your felony conviction unless you withdraw your application.
