AWARDING OF CREDITS

A student in a full credit course who fails one semester and passes the other semester may receive full credit if the average of the two semesters is 70 or above.

WEIGHTED POINT SYSTEM

Grand Prairie High School Advanced Placement (AP), Advanced Courses (formerly Pre-AP), and Dual Credit courses received weighted grade points. A cumulative GPA usually begins in the 9th grade and is updated after each semester. Students who take approved high school courses while in middle school receive the same grade points as the equivalent course taken in high school. Courses taken in middle school are designated by “J” on the transcript.
