- Fall 2020 there were 212 facilitators assigned to 892 courses
 - Data analysis report requested with following information

 - Amount of time facilitator was logged into course
 - What was the facilitator looking at when logged into course (i.e., grade center)?
 - Compiled report will be shared with ISD's
 - Data will assist us in improving facilitator program
